Project Elevate is... an energetic and highly interactive school-based program designed to engage and equip Caddo Parish students with positive and corrective behavior intervention skills. Helping students with high remittances to ISS attending economically challenged schools in economically challenged neighborhoods is our priority. **PE** is also available to all students selected to participate by school administrators. We believe that **PE** is the key to keeping students in their regular classrooms before out-of-school suspension or expulsion happens.



Who Runs the Program?... Established 2006, JAG Family Resource Center is a 501©3 agency who has been providing community outreach services to school age children, for over 30 years. Along with its partner companies, The Etiquette Training Center and RPJ Diversity Consultants, the urgent need for community-based, behavioral intervention programs for school age children is now being addressed! Successful trainings have been conducted at Turner Elementary & 6th Grade

Academy, University of Lakeshore Middle School, Volunteer's for Youth Justice and Fair Park Leadership Academy and now your school!

Schools First! ... The need for character education programs in our schools cannot be any higher than today. These skills were once only taught at home, but now with longer workdays, parents have less time for family togetherness and social skill development at home. Children of the 21st century spend many hours in front of the television where they learn valuable life skills through inappropriate images



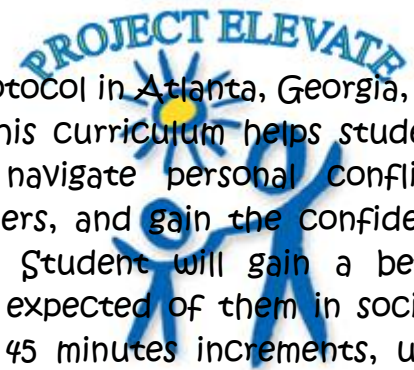
and programming, which crosses over into real life. Now, with increased access to the internet and social media, children soak-up even more rude behavior, which is displayed at school and in the community.

How We Help! The Goal... is to help students grow to become respectable, employable and contributing members of society by implementing a 1-3 day character education program in 12 schools throughout Caddo Parish.

The objectives... are to:

- (1) reduce the number of repeated ISS offenses by students
- (2) reduce demonstrated problem behaviors
- (3) increase student knowledge of preferred social skills
- (4) provide conflict & anger management skills to students
- (5) provide confidence & social skill development skills to Students

The Curriculum... is adapted from the America School of Protocol in Atlanta, Georgia, and teaches students proper conduct in various situations. This curriculum helps students



learn how to properly navigate personal conflicts, demonstrate proper manners, and gain the confidence they need to succeed. Student will gain a better understanding of what is expected of them in society. Each lesson is taught in 45 minutes increments, using age, gender and grade-level appropriate activities, homework assignments, quizzes and handouts. We ensure that students are fully-engaged for maximum retention and application into their everyday lives.



Pre/Post testing, program evaluations and counseling referral services are also used. On the last day parents, community leaders, volunteers and supporters are encouraged to attend the program completion ceremony to hear student testimonies and success stories!



The Impact... PE is a powerful character building program that seeks to prevent ISS, expulsion and student involvement in gangs vandalism, truancy and other violent crimes. The results... higher classroom attendance, positive learning outcomes and successful student!!
